Dear Parents & Guardians:

As we look forward to next year, we are excited to let you know that Abbotsford Middle School is a Bring Your Own Laptop (BYOL) school. A BYOL program allows opportunities to learn digital communication and citizenship skills within a structured and supervised setting. Students will also use online resources and digital tools to add to their already world-class Middle Years Program education at Abbotsford Middle. Using laptops as a tool, students are given access to assistive technologies and a wide variety of ways to digitally demonstrate their learning. All the while, students develop 21st century skills that include collaborating, creativity, and problem solving.

There is no specific device needed. We simply ask for a laptop or a tablet with a keyboard that can hold a charge for at least 3 hours and has internet capability. No specific software is required as most applications are available online. Before purchasing any device, we recommend you consider all purchasing options. The Abbotsford School District will continue with the Microsoft platform next year. Chromebooks will continue to work with this platform.

Each class has a small number of school district provided laptops available for use during class time. The purpose is to accommodate students that need to borrow a laptop during the day when their personal device might not be available, or to accommodate students who are unable to provide their own.
